

Portico Healthnet Coverage Program Fact Sheet



Portico Healthnet's coverage program provides access to primary and preventive medical and care management services to low income, uninsured people. **Portico is not health insurance.**

Who is eligible? People who:

- Live in Hennepin, Ramsey, Washington or Dakota Counties
- Have household incomes of less than 350% FPG (\$37,905 for a single person, or \$77,175 for a household of 4)
- Have no health insurance and are not eligible for Minnesota Health Care Programs

Typical Reasons why Portico participants are not eligible for state programs:

Employer offers subsidized insurance benefits which are unaffordable, immigration status, over asset limits, Legal Permanent Residents with sponsors, single adults who are over MnCare income limit

What services are covered?

- Primary clinic visits
- Specialty clinic visits
- Prescription medications (\$2,000 annual limit per person)
- Lab tests
- Outpatient mental health services
- Outpatient hospital procedures

What services are not covered?

- Emergency room
- Inpatient hospitalization
- Dental Care
- Pregnancy related services
- Chemical dependency treatment

What is the Participant's Financial Responsibility?

- Monthly fee of \$25-\$55 per household. Fee is sliding based on income and household size.
- Copays for prescriptions, non-preventive clinic visits, and specialty care visits
- Co-insurance of 25% for outpatient hospital procedures

How is the Portico Healthnet Coverage Program Funded?

Hospitals make a financial commitment to fund care through Portico. Portico enrolls individuals and uses the hospital dollars to reimburse medical providers when the participant uses health care services.
