Portico Healthnet Program Areas

Outreach and Enrollment Assistance

- Information about low cost and sliding fee clinics for medical, dental, and mental health care through 489-CARE line (651-489-2273)
- Screening for available health coverage options
- Assistance with Mn Health Care Program application process from initial application through enrollment
- Referrals from clinics, schools, government agencies, community organizations, word of mouth
- On-site staff at community locations, fax referral partnerships with referring agencies
- Assisted with enrollment of 3,271 individuals in Mn Health Care Programs during 2009
- Can serve anyone in MN, most are from metro area

Portico Health Care Coverage

- Provides access to primary and preventive medical and care management services to low income, uninsured people
- Covers clinic visits, specialty care, urgent care, prescriptions, outpatient mental health services, and outpatient hospital services
- Offered to residents of Ramsey, Hennepin, Dakota, and Washington Counties who are not eligible for MHCP and have incomes under 350% FPG (\$77,175 per year for family of 4 four, \$37,905 per year for a single person)
- Monthly fee of \$25-\$55 per household based on income. There are co-pays for some medical services
- Each household is assigned a Care Management Coordinator who can assist with navigating the health care system, chronic care planning, transitions to other health care coverage, and referrals to community services
